

Mother's Day Card

YOU WILL NEED

- 8 1/2" x 11" piece of paper, folded in half
- Any kind of paper to make flowers
- 3 – 4 circular objects of different sizes for tracing
- Scissors
- Glue
- Markers, crayons or pencils

STEPS

1. First go on a hunt in your home for items that are different color size circles. Look for large, medium and small circles. You can use caps, toys, cans, cups and even paper tubes.
2. Next find some paper to trace your circles onto. Construction paper, wrapping paper, tissue paper, even magazine paper works. Then trace some circles from the items you found onto the paper and cut them out.
3. The circles will be the head of the flowers for your card. Start with the largest circle and glue a medium sized on top, followed by the smallest circle. Be sure to add a stem to your flower and some leaves. You can draw your stem, use cut paper or even a green popsicle stick.
4. Be creative and have fun making your card! If you want to get fancy, snip the sides of your circles before you glue them, this makes your flower pedals pop out!
5. Once your card is finished, write or draw your mom a message inside telling her how much you love her.
