What are the dates and times of the Worldwide Lights Celebration Car Parade?

Weather permitting the Worldwide Lights Celebration Car Parade will be open Thursday – Sunday, 5:30 – 7:30 pm through January 3, 2021.

What is the cost?

Do I need to register in advance?

How long will the experience last?

The car parade is a two-minute ride around our Bus Circle. Upon arrival, families will receive a small puzzle and activity sheet to enjoy at home. *Only while supplies last.*

What time can I arrive?

We are open from 5:30 – 7:30 pm, Thursday – Sunday. You may arrive at any time during those hours. The last entry will be at 7:15 pm. Please have your confirmation email ready, printed or on your phone for check-in upon arrival. If you arrive before 5:30 pm, please wait for direction from museum staff.

What is the weather policy?

The car parade will not be open if there is rain or other inclement weather conditions. Our team will contact you to reschedule your reserved spot for another evening.

Will food and beverage be available?

Yes, our *Healthyville*® Cafe has prepared \$5.00 small snack bags that contain one beverage and healthy nut-free goodies. Card only, no cash accepted. *Limited amount available for purchase.*

Is photography permitted?

Will my family be able to get out of our vehicle during the car parade?
